The Community Action Team, as always, has played a particular role in finding and assisting such people. Through COVID-19 Response Program-2, we have delivered emergency food support among 2,126 households.

#### **COVID-19 Response Program-3**

Under the COVID-19 Response Program-(3), we have focused on the hospital facilities up-gradation and raising awareness on COVID-19. In terms of hospital facilities up-gradation, we have provided 20 patient beds, 19 oxygen concentrators, 38 Oxygen cylinders, 108 Pulse oximeters, 2 Sample collection booths, 24 Temperature measuring tools, 2 Handwashing booths, 60 face shields, 30 Nasal cannulas, 17 water filters, 60 Oxygen masks, and 7 Semi ICU beds.

In terms of raising awareness, our volunteer has played a vital role. They have conducted audio mass campaigns, distributed masks, and installed billboards.

Good Neighbors emphasizes "community mobilization" as a way of local-level participation for community development projects because it connects people and helps them cooperate and build up the necessary experience.

To resolve the structural poverty in the local community, each individual community member should be more than a project beneficiary and become an agent that takes the lead in bringing about change.

To do so, there should be ample opportunities for communication and Partnership within the community.

This is where Good Neighbors steps in: it promotes community mobilization and supports community members in building the necessary capacity. As expected, self-governing committees composed of community members served as the backbone of the project. The name of this committee is Community Development Committee (CDC).

#### Seminar on GNB CHW Research Report

We have organized a seminar called 25th Anniversary Seminar on GNB CHW Research Report on 7th July through webinar. In the field of Public Health, GNB CHW is one of the most significant interventions. Recently 241 Community Health Workers, 55 Skilled Birth Attendants (SBA) & 57 Certified Trained birth attendants (TBA) are contributing to 8 Upazilla's from 7 Districts in the field of maternal & child health under the supervision of GNB. CHW project was evaluated at five working areas by external researcher Dr. Nazneen Akhter, Founder and MD, VAALO Avant Grade Ltd.





In the seminar, she has shared the report with her suggestions for the improvement of CHW.

Among the participants in this seminar there were from, Government Health Officials, Nirvik Foundation and Shornokishoree, Jahangir Nagor University, Dustho Sasthyo Kendro (DSK), Friendship Bangladesh, Water Aid, CARITAS, World Vision, Kaler Kantho, KOICA-CPP, Good Neighbors International. As the chief guest there was Dr. Abu Jamil Faisel Public Health Expert Advisor, MOHFW & Chairman Health 21.







I am thankful to Good Neighbors Bangladesh for inviting me to such a seminar as a chief guest. I appreciate GNB's CHW Research Report presented by Dr. Nazneen Akhter. GNB CHW is the name of trust of the people, so I think it can be an example for the entire country.


